In between there will be lots of fun to be had with games, crafts, chill zone, and a variety of activities. (Depending on the camp these might include watersports, outdoor activities, nightline.) And of course on the last night we'll have a fire pit and smores!

About the speaker...

Paul O'Neill, the youth worker at Holywood Parish, Co Down, will be our speaker at all 3 camps. Having studied Chemical Engineering at Queen's University Belfast Paul decided to take a gap year as an intern at St Paul's Ealing in London. While there he felt the call of God to children's and youth ministry and from September 2016 has been serving as the youth worker in Holywood. Paul is a gifted communicator and is passionate about seeing the next generation engaged in



the local church, growing in their faith and released in their calling and giftings. Paul loves rugby and eating!

During our camps he'll be teaching on our theme, 'The way we walk.' We'll be learning about some Bible characters who walked closely with God and how we can follow Jesus daily in our lives.
